

MODERN ART MUSIC POSTER

Derwent Line and Wash Paint Pan Set

Grade Level: 6-12

MATERIALS:

- Derwent Line and Wash Paint Pan Set
- Derwent Push Button Waterbrush
- I Sheet 9 x 12 Paper

LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

This fun, energetic lesson brings music into the classroom! Use the Derwent Line and Wash Paint Pan Set to practice contour and overlay techniques, creating artistic music posters.






PROCEDURE:

Using the Sun Yellow Inktense paint and a waterbrush, paint a half moon shape at the top of the paper.



2 Using a contour drawing method, draw three stacked trumpets with the Line Maker. Draw the first trumpet facing right of the page. Try to draw the instrument so that it spans most of the width of the page from left to right.




3 With a darker Inktense tone, paint a silhouette of the trumpet, placing it just under the line drawing so the two are misaligned.







Below the first trumpet, draw a second trumpet facing left.



5 Repeat step three with the second trumpet, only this time select a lighter, brighter colour.




6 Underneath the second trumpet, draw a third trumpet facing right.





Repeat step three. Use a lighter, bright colour that you have not yet used.



8 Hand write customized words on the poster. We chose the title "Summer Jazz Fest".
