

DERWENT

IRRESISTIBLE INKTENSE FISHBOWL

Derwent Inktense Pencils

Grade Level: 9-12

MATERIALS:

- Derwent Inktense Pencils, Set of 12
- Derwent Waterbrush, 4 Pack
- White or Clear Crayon
- Watercolour Paper
- Derwent White Coloursoft Pencil
- Circle Template (optional)

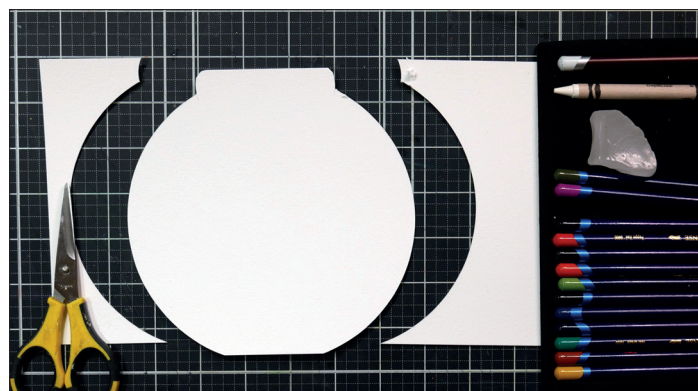
LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

Inspire creativity with these charming fishbowl drawings which use white crayon to play with wax resist.

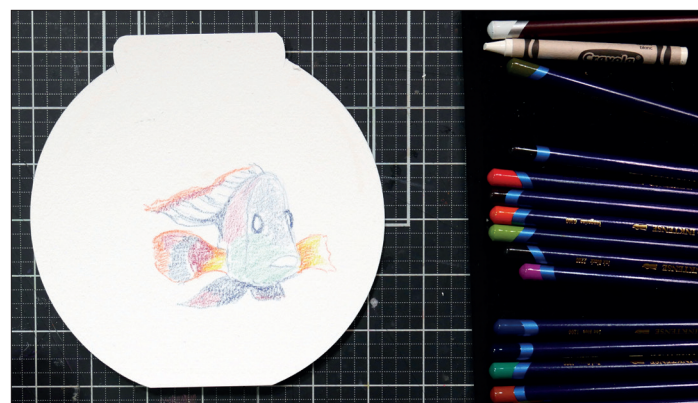


PROCEDURE:

- 1 Trim a piece of watercolour paper into a fishbowl shape. Use clear wax or a white crayon and firmly draw in bright white highlights on your fishbowl (refer to the finished project photo to guide you on placement as these highlights will represent the shiny reflections on the glass in the finished project).



- 2 Using the Inktense pencils, draw and colour in your focal point fish. Use the waterbrush to liquefy the pigment, locking in the ink and making it waterproof. Add more fish, gravel, and plants to the bowl as well, using the waterbrush to liquefy as you go.

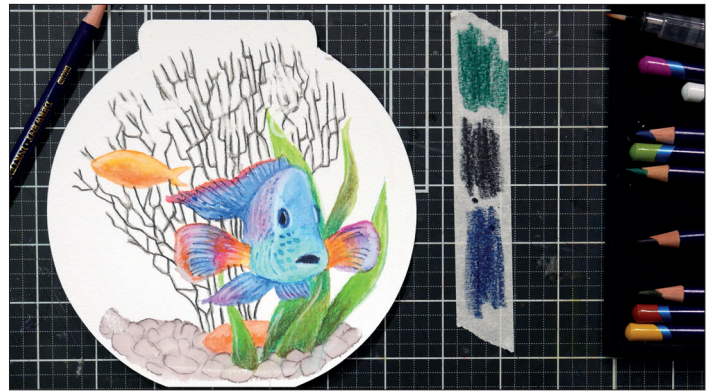


- 3 Use the White Coloursoft pencil with a circle template to draw bubbles around your focal point fish. Applying the Coloursoft pencil will create a subtle resist when you paint over it in the next steps.

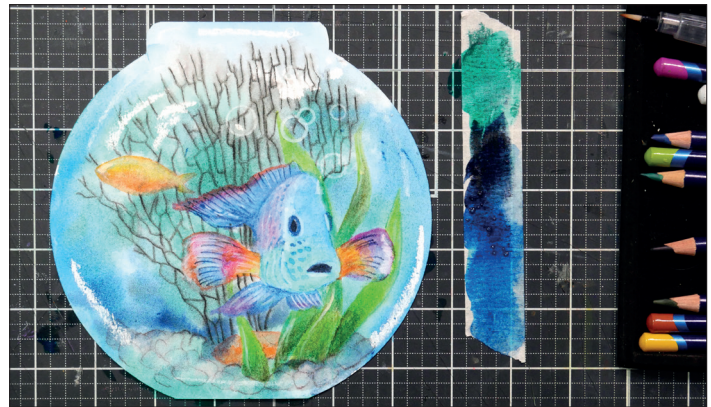

- 4 To create an interesting background, add a lacy plant with the Bark Inktense pencil. Use the waterbrush to carefully paint over the lines, locking down the pigment.



- 5 On a piece of masking tape scribble Deep Indigo, Sea Blue, and Teal Green Inktense pencils. Use the flat waterbrush to pick up the colours, and then paint over the entire fishbowl. Add darker watery stripes here and there to show movement. Make sure to leave the colour lighter above the waterline.



- 6 Continue to add details as desired and enjoy!
